



## *Book Project for Grief Camps*

Grief camps help children who have experienced a significant loss. Children gather, meet, interact and share their feelings (sadness, loneliness, anger,...) with other children who have experienced a loss. The children find they are not alone on their tough journey.

How does the project work?

- The Board of Directors of the grief camp decides they would like to participate in the book project.
- The Board chooses which books from the *Express Yourself* series they would like the campers to receive as a gift.
- Eagle Creek Publications contacts local businesses, churches, organizations about purchasing books for the campers to receive.
- Books are sold to sponsors at 25% discount.
- A gold label is placed opposite the title page with the following information:
  - Given by:
    - Name of business, church, or organization
    - Location – city and state
- Books are delivered by Eagle Creek Publications prior to the camp.
- Books are given to the campers at a time chosen by the Board of Directors.
